WAYS TO GIVE

- 1. SECURE ONLINE DONATION:** Scan the QR code with the camera app on a smart device or visit www.watertownunitedway.org and click on the red DONATE button on the right.
- 2. PAYROLL DEDUCTION:** Ask your employer for a pledge card. If your employer does not offer payroll deduction call UW for a pledge card or help get your employer on the list of campaign businesses for United Way.
- 3. BILL AT HOME:** Download a pledge card off the United Way website or stop by the office to grab one. United Way can send you a monthly, quarterly or an annual bill at home for your pledged amount.
- 4. MAIL:** Donations can be addressed to "Watertown Area United Way" and mailed to PO Box 283, Watertown, SD, 57201.
- 5. DROP OFF AT UW OFFICE:** Donations can be dropped off 24/7 at our office into a locked mailbox. Seal your donation in an envelope labeled "United Way" and insert into the building's mail slot. The mail slot is located to the right of the outside front door labeled with a sign saying "United Way Donation Drop Off".
- 6. ENDOWMENT FUND:** Give towards the Watertown Area United Way endowment fund held with the local community foundation. You can donate to the endowment online or by mailing a check. IMAGINATION LIBRARY

Since 2002, Watertown Area United Way and the Watertown Regional Library have worked hard to help 3,553 area youth graduate from the program and as of September 2021 have over 680 youth registered. Free monthly books are sent to youth ages 0-5 who live in Codington County or have a parent/guardian who works in Codington with no cap on household income.

Two books annually are published in both English and Spanish. Families can even receive braille copies through American Printing House under the Imagination Library's Braille Tales program. A total of 8,608 books were mailed out in 2020.

DELTA DENTAL MOBILE

Watertown Area United Way has brought the Delta Dental Mobile to the Watertown Area since 2011. In the summer of 2021, 90 youth were served and the value of dental care provided was over \$77,908 compared to the 2020 visit for only 11 week. 56 youth were provided \$28,498 in dental care.



Patients ages 0-71 were provided diagnostic, preventative, and restorative care and 421 sealants were placed in 2021. This was also the first time ever that the bus visited Watertown for more than one week.
